



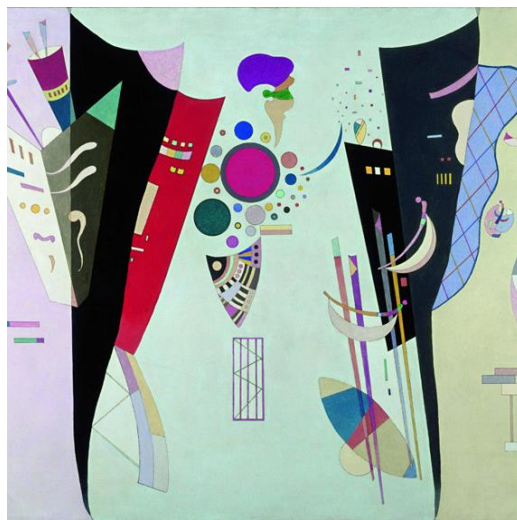

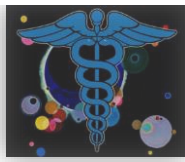

### Abstract

The "Cur'Arti", first project in Europe, is an innovative national network of collaborations between Hospitals and Institutes and Places of Culture that is aimed at launching projects of Social Inclusion, Accessibility, Art and psycho-corporeal rehabilitation through Art therapy. One of the goals of the project is also the creation of the first "Museum-Clinic" in Italy, extending the concept of cultural education to that of rehabilitation. The idea consists of the development of rehabilitation and psychological recovery laboratories through the art therapy, to enhance the extraordinary potential of patients affected by psychophysical conditions.

The project is based on the correspondence between Care and Beauty, and wants to incorporate art, culture, history and psychophysical rehabilitation.

## Structure of the project

### 1. AUDIENCE

*Who is the project aimed at?*

The project is aimed at a heterogeneous audience in terms of age, gender and education.

Specifically, the project concerns mostly:

- Patients affected by chronic and acute pathologies (autism, Alzheimer disease etc.)
- Adolescents and young people affected by juvenile distress
- Disabled people
- Immigrants

### 2. GOALS

What are the goals of the project?

- Direct the project to the vulnerable categories (people under treatment, immigrants, disabled people, children in cultural poverty in warring countries as well as in countries at peace) by employing specific communicative registers and methods of use, but also by keeping in mind their specific needs, in compliance with the 2005 UNESCO Convention that underlines the importance of culture as a tool of social cohesion.
- Creation of a "Museum-Clinic" to establish the Art therapy in hospitals and museums as an official therapy for patients affected by chronic pathologies, practiced by first level professionals (psychiatric rehabilitators, psychiatrists, psychologists etc.)
- Develop a "museum education" for different audiences, taking advantage of digital techniques and tools to make the understanding of the cultural heritage easier and implement its knowledge through stimulating and immersive methods that involve the user by activating their senses and mind.
- Make the use of cultural contents accessible in care environments (hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, rehabilitation structures etc.) both via hardware installation and software installation, available online remotely through dedicated web platform that can be implemented through a bottom-up approach.

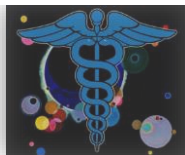

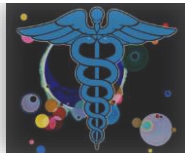
